The sound system have to be installed, tested and calibrated before the arriving of the musician and his technician.

The person responsible of the sound system will have to stay from the sound check to the end of the show.

House PA System

The System should be capable of producing a full and even sound coverage of the complete audience.

Subwoofers are obligatory for this show.

The system should further be capable of achieving a sound pressure level of 90 dB at the last row with plenty of headroom. The system's frequency response shall be even from 30 Hz to 18 kHz.

Preferred brands of speakers are EAW, D&B, Meyer sound, Adamson and Turbosound.

Preferred power amplifiers are Crest or Crown.

House System Console

Midas, Yamaha, Soundcraft providing a minimum of 16 input channels with good preamps are acceptable. Further minimum requirements are 4 aux sends, 4 bands parametric EQ on each channel, channel insert patching and microphone/line inputs with PAD.

House Processing Gear

- -1/3 Octave Equaliser in each output channel of the system (BSS, Klark)
- -1 CD player
- -2 programmable reverbs (Lexicon, TC)
- -1 programmable effect Delays with tap tempo
- -2 Compressor/De-Esser (BSS DPR 402)

Monitoring System

2 full range wedge cabinets on 2 output channel shall be provided on stage. Each one of the speakers must be capable of producing 115 dB SPL at 1m distance. A 1/3 octave equaliser shall be inserted in each output channel.

- 1 **SM 91 Shure**
- 1 Neumann KMS 105
- 1 SM 58 Shure (talkback)



Accomodation
